Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for construction for a new Regional Emergency Services and Training Facility in fiscal year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is Morgan County Fiscal Court, located at 1412 Highway 7, West Liberty, Kentucky 41472.

The funding would be used to build a public safety facility to serve as a permanent EMS headquarters and centralized hub for paramedic, EMT, and search-and-rescue training, significantly expanding local training capacity and supporting the development of a skilled public safety workforce, while strengthening emergency response capabilities and promoting long-term economic stability across eastern Kentucky.

This project has a federal nexus because it is for the purposes authorized in Section 306 of the Consolidated Farm and Rural Development Act, 7 U.S. Code section 1926(a).
